



## **Law Firm of Friedman Schuman Celebrates 20th Anniversary; Relocates Headquarters into New, Larger Space in Jenkintown to Accommodate Firm Growth**

"Over the past three years we have seen significant rise in revenues annually," said Schuman. "Revenues grew 20 percent in 2006, more than 25 percent in 2007 and projections for this year are very optimistic. Our goal is to continue this impressive trend and to employ more than 30 lawyers in the near future," he continued.

Schuman explained there are good reasons for this growth. "First, we believe we are offering Center City legal talent to individuals and businesses in the suburban market without them having to go downtown, and second, is our expansion of niche markets," he said.

"For example, our firm's municipal law practice now serves as solicitor for ten area municipalities, making it the fastest growing municipal law practice in the entire commonwealth and our litigation practice has realized some very considerable and noteworthy settlements," Schuman said.
