



**Local Attorney Discusses
“Understanding Car Insurance”
on WIP’s Public Affairs Show “Conversations”**

Jenkintown, PA – Ask most people if they have adequate car insurance coverage and they will most likely insist they do. Ask most people if they understand their car insurance coverage and they will tell you they do not. That is why Bob Nemeroff, a litigator and shareholder with the law firm, Friedman Schuman, who represents injured accident victims, recently told WIP’s listeners what they need to understand about car insurance to purchase the proper coverage.

According to Nemeroff, most of us are underinsured and opt out of coverages we should maintain to save money on our premiums. “Many people make uninformed choices in the interest of saving money without understanding the consequences of their decisions until they are in an accident. We all pay a lot of money for car insurance and we should fully understand what we are buying.”

Among the other advice he offered was to select full tort, purchase the highest policy limit for each coverage you can afford, do not waive uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage and select “stacking” for uninsured motorist and underinsured motorist if you insure more than one vehicle.
